## **Tips for Achieving Best Signature Stamp Results**

- 1. Sign your name on a clean white sheet of paper.
- 2. Use Solid Black Ink Pen to ensure that your signature stands out and appears clear when stamped.
- 3. Avoid using paper with lines, grids, or any other markings, as these will appear on the stamp.
- 4. Avoid Felt Tip Markers, as they can cause issues with certain letters (like 'a,' 'e,' and 'o') filling in when stamped.
- 5. Think about the desired finished impression. A larger signature may require a larger stamp to maintain clarity.
- 6. If there are breaks or irregularities in the letters, these will be reflected on the stamp.
- 7. When scanning a signature, ensure that the glass surface is spotless. For phone-based scans or photos it's important to have strong lighting to enhance the black and white contrast.
